Billy G. Graywolf, 71, passed away Sunday, December 27, 2020 at his home in Webb City. Billy was born June 4, 1949 in Buffalo, NY to William Stephen and Paula Ann (Kindel) Barton, Sr. He was a bus driver in the Grand Canyon and on the Navaho Indian Reservation, an artist, a member of the American Legion and a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans Association. Billy served in the United States Navy from 1968 to 1974 during the Vietnam War as a radar technician for the mine sweeper on the USS Guide, receiving the Nation Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, a Bronze Star and a Combat Action Ribbon.

Billy was united in marriage to Feathers Graywolf on July 5, 2003 in Reno, NV; she survives.
