Arlow B. Chapman, age 84, passed away on Tuesday, July 19, 2022 in Joplin, Missouri. He was born December 26, 1937 in Alba, Missouri. Arlow was a longtime Carthage, Missouri resident before residing in Joplin. He attended K.C. Central Institute of Technology where he earned his degree in electronics. Arlow Joined the Navy in 1958 where he served his country for six years and was stationed on the U.S.S. Boston. He was an engineer for KODE-TV and an electronic technician for LeBarge Electronics. Some of Arlow's interests were Ham radios, sailing, motorcycles, listening to news talk radio and dabbling with any type of electronic. "Pap" as his family referred to him as, had a kind caring soul.
