Bob Russell Barlow, 82, passed away on Monday, January 22, 2024, at his home surrounded by his loving family. Bob was born on March 8, 1941, in Dallas, Texas, to Willis Barlow and Marie (Halerman) Barlow. He's been a Carthage resident since 1996. In his younger years, he was a journeyman mailer for several larger city newspapers. Later, he drove a truck for JB Hunt and was a recipient of the 1 Million Mile Accident-Free Driver award. 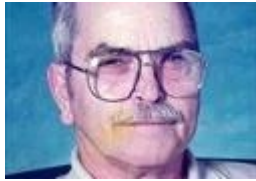

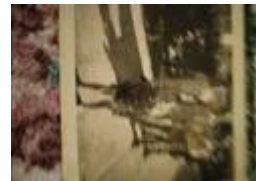
