



## Chester Durham Swan

November 10, 1945 - February 28, 2022

Chester Durham Swan, 76, passed away Monday, February 28, 2022 at home in Carthage, Missouri. Chester was born November 10, 1945 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina to Chester W. Swan and Antoinette “Barrow” Swan. He graduated with the class of 1964 from Gray High School in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. Chester then attended Georgia Southern and Gardner Webb in Georgia.
