Dana George, 54, of Carthage, Missouri, passed away on Thursday, March 3, 2022, in Mercy Hospital Carthage. Dana was born on June 3, 1967, in Columbia, Missouri. She was raised in Higginsville, Missouri then attended Ozark Christian College starting in 1985. She lived in the Atlanta Metro area from '96 to '99, and in '99 she moved to Ohio. She resided in the Atlanta Metro area once again for about 16 years and was actively involved at Calvary Chapel of McDonough, Georgia, before moving to Carthage, Missouri.
