Eual Thomas Moore, 90, of Mt. Vernon, Missouri, passed away on Monday, May 11, 2026, at Cox Monett Hospital in Monett. Eual was born on December 24, 1935, to John and Amy Moore in Mt. Vernon. He grew up in Mt. Vernon and upon high school graduation, he joined the U.S. Navy and served from February 1954 to February 1962. He then worked for McDonalds for 36 years and retired in 1976.
