Frances (Patton) Russow, 87, of Carthage passed away at 11:55 a.m., Thursday, December 9, 2010 at Freeman Hospital. She was born on June 24, 1923, in Miller, Missouri. Frances was the daughter of Mack Patton and Lena (Gee) Patton. She came to Carthage in 1941 and attended school in South Sycamore and Miller, MO. Frances worked in Carthage at Standard Brands, McCune Brooks Hospital for twenty-two years and volunteered for the Red Cross Bloodmobile for twenty years.
