Gary Keith Rosenthal of Carthage passed away on Friday, May 21, 2010. He was born on January 30, 1940 in Big Springs, NE to Gerald Rosenthal and Theo (Pope) Rosenthal. Gary worked as a mechanic and in the oil fields in Kansas until moving to Carthage in December 1965. He delivered Mobile Homes for 38 years, retiring in 2005. Gary was a Drag Racer for 45 years, racing in Topeka, KS.; the 4-State Area and at Mo-Kan. He was the first member inducted to the Mo-Kan Hall Of Fame.
