March 9, 1929 - May 30, 2011

Retired Sargent Gleman E. Keller, 82, of Carthage, Missouri passed away at 7:30p.m. on Monday, May 30, 2011 at McCune Brooks Hospital. Gleman was born on March 9, 1929 in Carthage, Missouri. Gleman retired from the Missouri State Highway Patrol after 33 years of service. Gleman was a veteran of the Air Force where he taught at the Aircraft and Engineering school in Wichita Falls, Texas. Gleman was a member of the First Church of Nazarene in Carthage. He was a member of the Wrinkled Roosters Club, and a graduate of the Class of 1948 at Carthage High School. Gleman married Pauletta Sanders on November 24, 1949 in Carthage, Missouri. She survives.
