Herman F. Calvin, 90, of Carthage, Missouri, passed away on Wednesday, November 22, 2023, at his home. He was born on August 31, 1933, to Jesse Calvin and Marie (Duncan) Calvin in La Russell, Missouri. Herman has been a lifetime resident of Carthage, served his country in the Navy, and was employed at Safeway Food where he retired after 37 years.
