



## Hollis Paul Osborne

September 12, 1929 - February 22, 2022

Hollis Paul Osborne, 92, of Carthage, Missouri passed away Tuesday, February 22, 2022 at Freeman Hospital in Joplin, Missouri.

Hollis was born in Golden City, Missouri on September 12, 1929 to Olyn Ralph Osborne and Lilly Pearl “Howard” Osborne. He was the oldest of three children, with a brother, Jack Osborne and a sister, MayBelle Osborne Adams.
