Jacquelyn “Jacquie” Florence Rush-Weissenberger (nee Peterson) passed away on Sunday, November 19, 2017. Jacquie was born on October 23, 1932 in Chicago, IL to Frederick and Virginia Peterson.

Jacquie was originally trained in office administration, but over the years she became self-employed cleaning homes.

Jacquie married Gaylord D. Rush in 1950. They began their married life in Illinois where they had four children: James, Gaylin, Valerie and Steven. In 1975, they moved to Carthage, MO where Gaylord was the owner/operator of Rush Sheet Metal until he retired.

Years after Gaylord’s passing, Jacquie married Harry Weissenberger, also of Carthage. Harry preceded Jacquie in death on May 11, 2017.

Jacquie is survived by son, James of Illinois; daughter, Gaylin and husband Leon of Missouri; daughter, Valerie and husband Robert of Illinois; and son, Steven and wife Sue of Idaho, along with numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.
