Katherine M. "Ball" Robinson, 95, passed away Sunday, August 23, 2020 in Carthage, MO. Katherine was born March 11, 1925 in Holyoke, MN to Thomas Arthur Ball and Margaret "Heinz" Ball. She was a homemaker and made bombs during World War II and also worked as a meat wrapper before she started to have a family. She was a member of the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church. Katherine volunteered at the Mercy-McCune Brooks Hospital for over 40 years in the gift shop and the front desk, as well as the Red Cross.

Katherine was united in marriage to Charles J. Robinson on June 16, 1945 in Minneapolis, MN; he preceded her in death October 16, 1991.
