Leroy Sharp, 76, a lifetime Carthage resident passed away at 2:37, a.m., May 12, 2010 at St. Johns Regional Medical Center. He was born on May 7, 1934 in Stella, Missouri. Leroy was the son of Elmer Graves Sharp and Esther Clymer Sharp Erwin. He owned and operated Leroy's Washer Service for 25 years. Leroy served in the United States Army. He served two tours from 1957-1959 in Germany then from 1961-1962 in the Cuban Crisis as a Radio Repair Man. He was a Carthage graduate from the class of 1952. He also served on the city Council. Leroy was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene, Carthage. Leroy married Susann "Richardson" Sharp on September 9, 1960 in Carthage, she survives.
