Opal Faye Campbell, 79, passed away Monday, November 18, 2019 at Communities of Wildwood Ranch in Joplin. Opal was born August 5, 1940 in Carthage to Carl W. and Agnes M. "Simpson" Brooks. 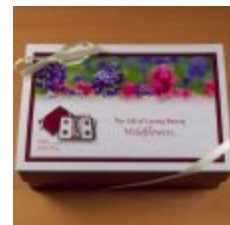
