Orval B. Stever, 88, passed away October 22, 2012 in Carthage MO. Orval was born on July 10, 1924 in Springfield, Missouri to Jesse and Faye Marie (Carden) Stever. Orval served in the Army as a Major during World War II and the Korean War. He was a recipient of the Bronze Star.
