Ike Heisten Paul L. "Ike" Heisten Sr., a lifetime Carthage Resident, passed away at 1:05 p.m., Saturday, November 21, 2009 at Carthage Health and Rehabilitation. Paul was born on July 16, 1918, in Carthage. He was the son of Jacob Heisten and Rosa "Core" Heisten. Paul farmed east of Carthage for several years. He was a distributor for DX Sun oil in the 1960's and had a local fertilizer business in the 1970's. Paul was a member of the Bethany Baptist Church and later attended Victory Baptist Church. He was part of the former city baseball league in his youth then coached little league baseball in the 1950's and 1960's and he enjoyed fishing in his retirement years. Paul married Ruth "Gipson" on July 26, 1941 in Springfield, Missouri. She preceded him in death on February 8, 2007.
