



## Reggie Hibdon

August 18, 1941 - December 12, 2022

Reggie Glen Hibdon, 81, of Carthage, MO, passed away on Monday, December 12, 2022, after a brief illness. Reggie was born on August 18, 1941, in Perris, CA, to Olen Oliver Hibdon and Hope Geraldine (Lamb) Hibdon.
