Thomas F. Dabbs, 81, passed away November 24, 2017 at Mercy Hospital in Springfield, Missouri. Tom was born April 1, 1936 in Reeds, Missouri to Joseph Fern Dabbs and Addie Crystal "Stansbury" Dabbs.
