William "Neal" Carter, 85, passed away at 10:26 p.m. Sunday, October 30, 2011 at his home. Neal was born December 19, 1925 in Carthage. He was the son of John William Carter and Emily Pearl "Davis" Carter. Neal graduated from Carthage High School with the class of 1943. He served in the United States Navy during World War II. Neal worked from 1952 to 1980 in the family dairy and then for Lee Ru Dairy. He worked for the Webb City School District from 1980 to 1987. Neal was a member of the First Baptist Church in Carterville where he served as a Deacon, taught Men's Class, sang in the choir and served on the board of Trustees for many years. He was also a member of the Challenger Gospel Quartet. Neal married Frances Ruth Page on June 28, 1949 in Denver, CO. She preceded him in death in May 1979.
